YOUR ACADEMICS

Transcripts

Upload transcripts from all undergraduate and graduate academic institutions that you have attended; you may upload "unofficial" copies of your transcripts. A bachelor's degree or equivalent is required to apply.

GMAT or GRE

You must take the test before you submit your application. HBS has no preference on which test you take.

English Language Tests

A TOEFL, IELTS, PTE, or Duolingo English Test is required if you did not attend an undergraduate institution where the sole language of instruction was English.

REFLECT

Essay

Submit three short essays. This is your opportunity to share meaningful or formative experiences that are important to you that you haven't gotten a chance to fully explore elsewhere in your application.
